Multi-Factor Authentication

NFA

- MFA is a login method requiring users to provide an additional verification factor to gain access to a system, beyond a username and password.
- For NFA system users, the additional factor will be a timebased one-time passcode delivered to the user via email, text message/phone call or an authenticator app.
- Users can select their preferred option upon enrollment and will only need to enroll once.

Multi-Factor Authentication

- Every enrollment procedure begins on the same login page (<u>slide #6</u>) before selecting from one of three MFA options.

Exemptions

Commodity pool operators (CPO) and commodity trading advisors (CTA) must electronically file with NFA notices of exclusion or exemption from <u>CFTC Part 4 Requirements</u> using NFA's Exemptions System. In order to access this system, the firm's security manager(s) must <u>set up EasyFile</u> <u>security</u>.

Annual Affirmation Process

CFTC regulations require any person claiming an exemption or exclusion from CPO registration under CFTC Regulation 4.5, 4.13(a)(1), 4.13(a)(2), 4.13(a)(3), 4.13(a)(5) or an exemption from CTA registration under 4.14(a)(8) to annually affirm the applicable notice of exemption or exclusion within 60 days of the calendar year end. At the end of each year, NFA emails a reminder of the affirmation period. The affirmation process can be completed by logging into the Exemptions System below.

Effective with the affirmation ending March 1, 2021, persons re-affirming an exemption under 4.13(a)(1), 4.13(a)(2), 4.13(a)(3) and 4.13(a)(5) will be required to attest that neither the person nor its principals has in its background any statutory disqualifications listed under Section 8a(2) of the Commodity Exchange Act.

For registered CPOs or CTAs, withdrawal of the exemption/exclusion will result in the firm being subject to Part 4 Requirements for that pool regardless of whether the firm otherwise remains eligible for the exemption/exclusion. For non-registrants, the withdrawal of the exemption may subject you to enforcement action by the CFTC.

- 2. Click "continue."

NFA

NFA recommends using "Microsoft Authenticator" or "Google Authenticator" apps for a time-based one-time passcode.

Note: Regardless of the app you use, you must enroll in multi-factor authentication separately for each user account. If you are affiliated with multiple firms and have multiple user accounts, click the plus sign button in your authenticator app to enroll each account separately.

1. Download the authenticator app onto your mobile device.



2. Enroll your account by scanning the QR code using the authenticator app.
